- ☺ Making the school aware of any concerns or problems that may affect their child's learning.
- ☺ Adopting and supporting the schools policy on behaviour.
- ☺ Ensuring their child is at school regularly and on time and informing the school if not.
- ☺ Supporting their child's learning by being involved in any homework / reading activities they may have on a regular basis.
