# WHAT IS PUPIL PREMIUM?

How Does it Help?

The Pupil Premium is EXTRA GOVERNMENT MONEY which is paid to schools to SUPPORT children in reaching their potential. We, as a school, will ensure that you and your child will benefit from this extra funding.

**BUT WE CAN ONLY APPLY FOR THIS IF YOU CLAIM YOUR FREE SCHOOL MEALS THAT YOU ARE ALREADY ENTITLED TO – EVEN AFTER YEAR 2**

If your child is eligible for pupil premium, the school receive more funding to ENABLE US to enhance provision

If you qualify you could also benefit from..

- ✓ Subsidised cost of school trips, including residential trips.
- ✓ Supermarket vouchers to use during school holidays

The school can only receive PP funding when YOU apply for free school meals

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income based JobseeKer's Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit
- Universal Credit

If you qualify for free meals, what does the school receive?

School gets money for each pupil who fits the eligibility criteria. We get different amounts of funding depending on the support type

- Pupils in year groups EYFS to Y6 who are in receipt of free school meals: £1385
  - Pupils in the care of the Local Authority or previously in care of the Local Authority: £2410
  - Pupils with Parents in the Regular Armed Forces: £320
- \*2022/2023 figures



Even if your child is in Key Stage 1, it is important that if you receive a qualifying benefit you still register for free school meals under the eligibility scheme, so that we can get the extra money to help with their education.
