

Reception Homework Spring 1 2026

**EVERY DAY** – Your child should be encouraged to say the sounds and read the words in their reading books. Children should look and read some of their book each night. If children have flash cards in their bags, please have a look at them during the week and ask the children what sounds the letters make.

**EVERY WEEK- ideally 3 x in the week** – Your child should practise writing out numbers to 5, making sure they are formed correctly. They could also practise writing their name using a tripod grip position with their pencil. Children can also practice writing other labels such as names of people who live in their house and pet names or simple sentences e.g. it is a dog.

<p><u>Week 1- 13<sup>th</sup> January 2026-</u></p> <p>To draw a picture of different winter clothes and to write labels of what they are.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> The children will be learning how to read and write CVCC words and VCC words. (Consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant and vowel, consonant, consonant.)</p>	<p><u>Week 2- 20<sup>th</sup> January 2026</u></p> <p>Select a small amount of toys or pieces of food e.g. raisins (up to 10). Grown up to ask what is one more or one less. Repeat with different amounts of toys/food.</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> to write down in homework book the results.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> The children will be learning how to read and write CVCC words and VCC words. (Consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant and vowel, consonant, consonant.)</p>	<p><u>Week 3- 27<sup>th</sup> January 2026</u></p> <p>To help an adult at home. This can anything from tidying up to helping cook dinner. Share pictures on Tapestry.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> The children will be learning how to read and write ccvc words. (Consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant).</p>
<p><u>Week 4- 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2026</u></p> <p>To find the number 0 in the house or while out of the house e.g. on a keyboard or on a number plate. Pictures can be shared on Tapestry.</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> to write numbers to 10 in homework book.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> The children will be learning how to read and write ccvc words. (Consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant).</p>	<p><u>Week 5- 10<sup>th</sup> February 2026</u></p> <p>To write a list of things that an Explorer would need in the Antarctic. For example, coat, gloves, hat etc.</p> <p><b>Extension:</b> To add pictures by the side of the words.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> The children will be learning how to read and write ccvc words. (Consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant).</p>	<p><u>Extra homework:</u></p> <p>To learn some facts about Chinese New Year.</p>
